Protect your rights

- Negotiate the copyright for your publications with **GW's Addendum to Publication Agreement**
- Assign a **Creative Commons License** to your work, if you choose

Preserve your work

- Get a permanent URL for your publication -- **no more dead links**
- Let **GW ScholarSpace**, our institutional repository, take care of permanent maintenance and backups of your publications, with no need to worry about personal/commercial servers
- Consolidate your publications all in one place for easy discovery

Increase your impact

- Get your publications **cited earlier and more frequently** -- studies show, openly accessible publications make a bigger mark
- Make your work visible through popular search engines like **Google and Google Scholar**
- Allow a wide range of researchers and the public to benefit from your knowledge and research, beyond your university and beyond your field
